### WHO IS AN ADVANCED STUDENT?

An advanced student is a fashion enthusiast who is interested in bridal and couture dressmaking. This masterclass is for students who have an idea in pattern making and would like to brush up their skills and knowledge.

## Things you should know about SBLFA:

- The duration for this program is three (3) months only.
- We run three (3) batches in a year(January Batch, May Batch and september Batch)
- At SBLFA, we teach using pattern drafting cutting technique.
- We teach womenswear fashion only.
- A professional certificate of achievement will be issued upon completion of the intensive training program.
- Students are advised to get their sewing machine to work with at home.
- At the end of each course, students will be given projects for the end of session assessments.



- Certificates will not be given if project is not completed and submitted.
- All trainings are physical and onsite.
- All fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
